



CHSRA D2 Battle for the Saddle Rodeo
Equestrian Center at Rolling Hills, Corning, CA.
January 31- February 3, 2019



We are getting ready for our first interdistrict Battle for the Saddles Rodeo at the Equestrian Center at Rolling Hills. This rodeo will award **saddles** to the HS All-Around average cowboy and cowgirl, **jackets** to reserve all-around, **buckles** to each event average winners, and **saddle blankets** or **knives** to go-around winners. Event winners are based on the average and All-Around Awards are based on total points. In the event of an All-Around tie, the winner will be decided on money won. Both arenas are covered, so the rodeo will take place rain or shine.

This is a sanctioned rodeo (points count for your district) for 1-3 for **ALL EVENTS**.

All entry fees include a jackpot fee for each event entered. HS will be paid on the average.

Please check off this list when sending in the appropriate forms:

- ★ Your entry form for the Battle of the Saddles must be completed and postmarked by **January 15, 2019**. Please mail to the appropriate address on the entry form.
- ★ Grade Verification and Release of Liability Agreement:
 - This is included in the entry form
- ★ School seal/stamp must be over the signature.

- ★ Stalling/Camping Reservations:
 - Stalls and camping are completed on a separate form and mailed to the separate address on that form.
 - Grounds will open on Thursday, January 31st
 - If you plan on camping together, please write it on the camping form. No guarantees but we will try our best.
 - Shavings will be for sale on-site. One bag is provided for you
 - Event staff will be handling parking and stalling.

“Set-Ups”:

- ★ No “set-ups” for Cutting and Reined Cow Horse
- ★ “Set-up” forms must be included with your entry and postmarked by January 15th.

Reined Cow Horse/Cutters Check-in: 3:00-4:00 PM on Thursday, January 31st. 1st Go of Cutting starts at 5:00 PM. 2nd Go to follow 1st go.

Reined Cow Horse: If not already checked-in office will be open from 7:00-8:00 PM Thursday January 31st. RCH is 1 Go only starting at 7:00 AM Friday, February 1st.

All Others: February 1st office open 8:00 AM – 10:00 AM. All contestants except those on “set-up” must check-in or prior arrangements made with the rodeo secretary.

Mandatory Ground Rules Meeting will be at 10:30 AM on February 1st. Boys and girls events will begin at 11:00-11:30 AM in both arenas.

Friday there will be a Jackpot Barrel Race at 5:30 PM or following the end of the rodeo put on by District 3.
